

## **DEBENHAM PARISH COUNCIL – Summary of the Parish Council Meeting held Monday 20 February 2017**

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**Planning:** Application no 0030/17 – land bounded by Derry Brook Lane and Little London Hill: A number of concerns were raised about issues such as vehicular access and traffic increase in an already challenging hot spot, the lack of infrastructure to accommodate the resulting needs, considerable flood risks and threat to wildlife. As a result, the Council resolved to recommend the refusal of this planning application.

**Highways:** Disappointment was expressed at how road works had recently been managed. This had caused serious problems in a number of areas and a response would be sought from SCC Highways in due course.
